

Directions to Sandy Point State Park Youth Area Camping Approximate Mileage 45 miles

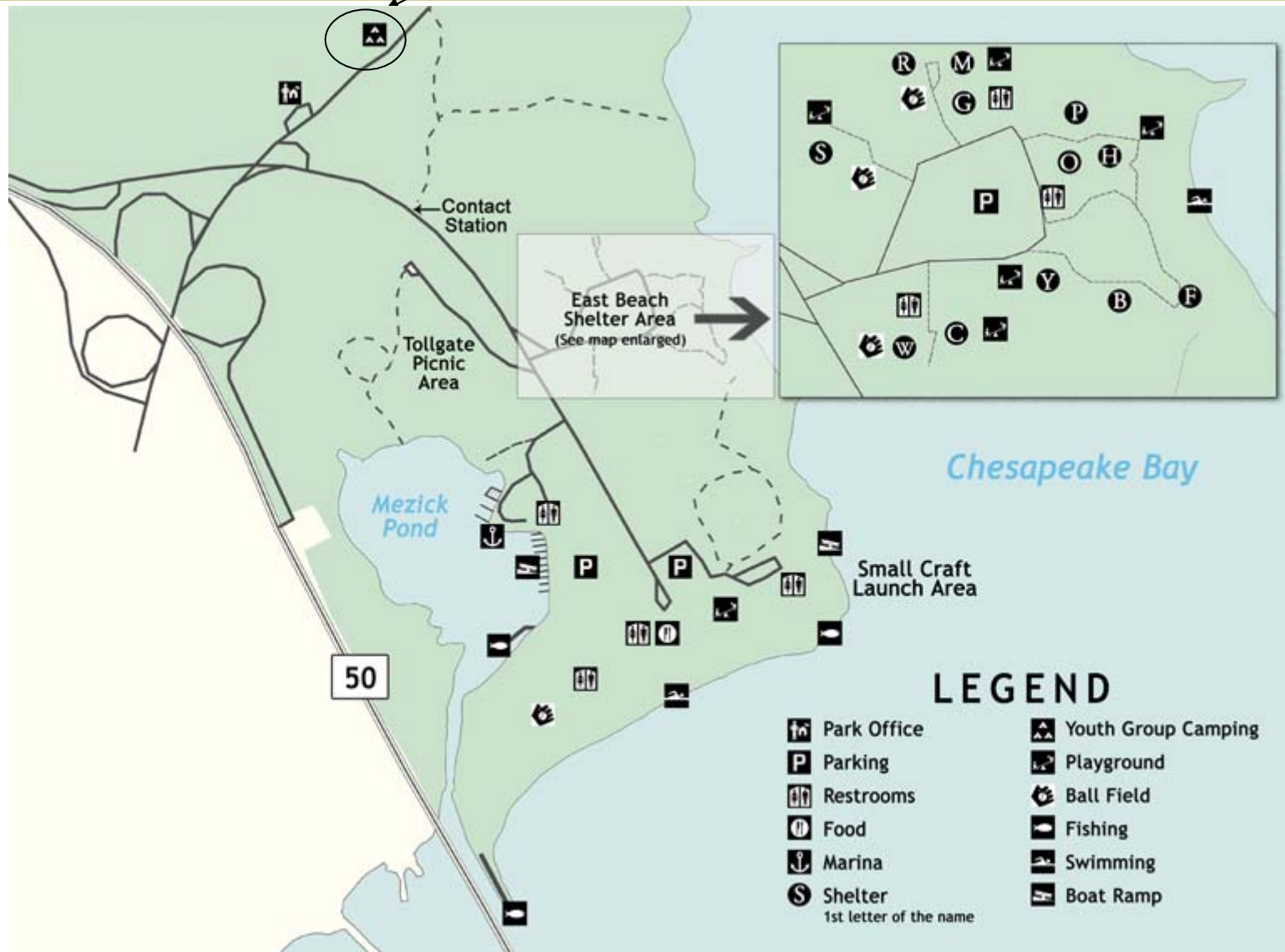
- 1 Harford Rd NORTH to beltway I-695 East toward Essex
- 2 Take **exit #33A** onto **I-95 SOUTH** toward Washington / Baltimore
- 3 Take **LEFT Fork** onto **I-895 South** (Harbor Tunnel) toward Annapolis
- 4 After the tunnel take I-895 **Exit #6 Bay Bridge / Annapolis**
- 5 Take **MD-2 South** onto **I-97 South** toward **Bay Bridge / Annapolis**
- 6 **Follow** signage while on **I-97** toward **Bay Bridge** via **US- 50** and **MD-301**
- 7 Take **Exit #32 Oceanic Drive** toward **Sandy Point State Park** (this is last exit before Bay Bridge)
- 8 Turn **Left** on **Oceanic Drive**
- 9 Follow **Oceanic Drive** past **main entrance to Sandy Point State Park** (Day Use area)
- 10 Look for **Youth Area Camping Entrance / Gate**.

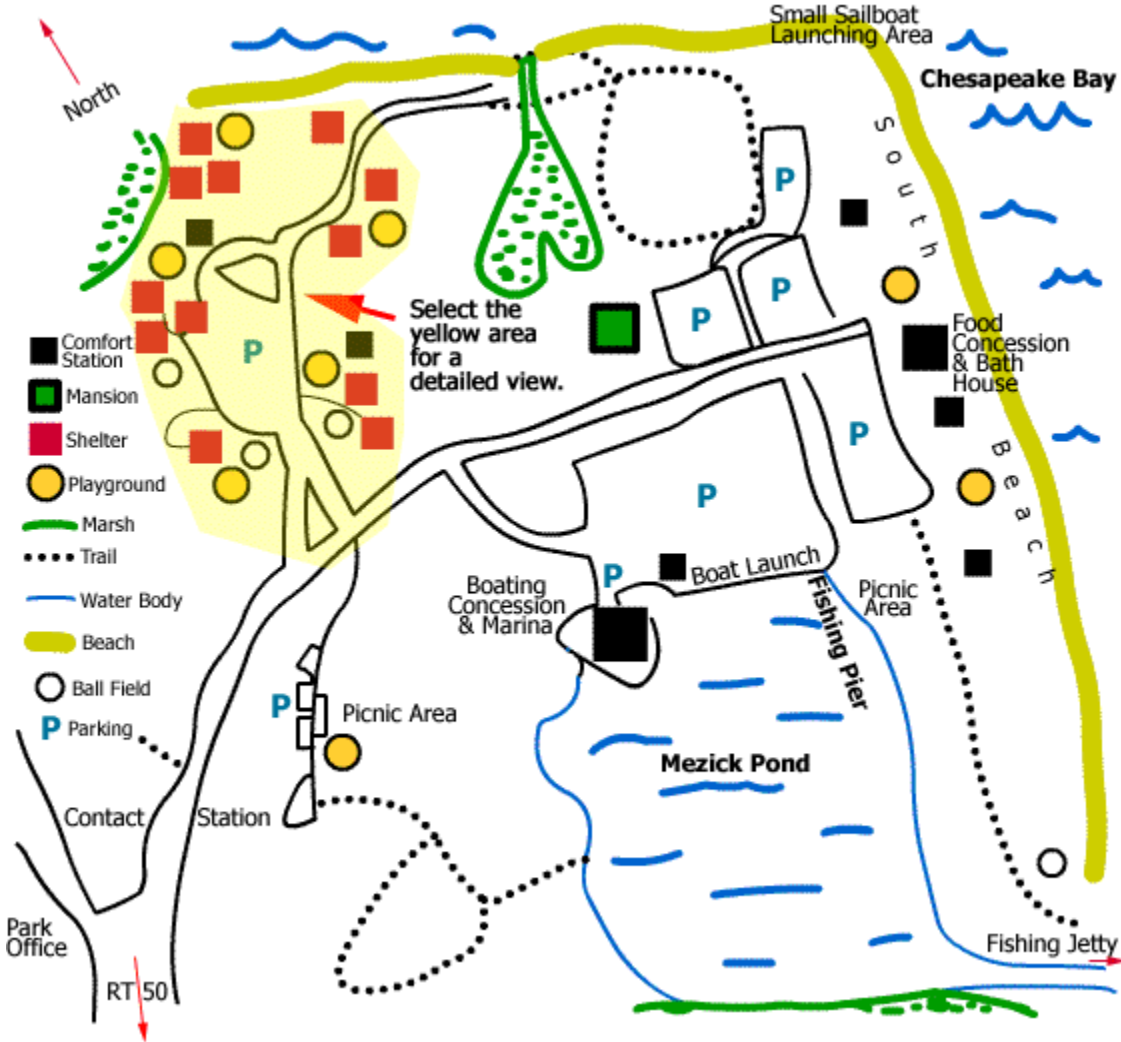
Sandy Point State Park Map
