Clothes

- Socks- 4 Pairs (2 sets layered)
- Underwear – 3 pair (1 per day, for all of you sanitary people)
- Warm Pajamas (Flannel is good) – NO CLASS A PAJAMAS
- Pants – 2 pairs- Whatever is comfortable and warm (Wind-pants for snow)

- Flannel Shirt or Sweat Shirt – Hoodies are a good choice
- T-Shirts – 2 (either layered or you have an extra in case of wetness)
- Hat and Gloves + the ever popular earmuffs
- Extra Gloves
- Class A
- Class B Shirt – Usually comes in handy
- Thermal Underwear – 1-2 pairs, depending on what you own
- Parka – Heavy Coat

Knick-Knacks

- Hand Warmers – They are great
- Cup suitable for hot beverages
- Generic knick-knacks – For every trip (flashlight, knife, etc.)
- Sleeping Bag – Should be suitable for the temperature
- Foam Pad – Under sleeping bag for softness and to keep air out from under you
- Extra Blanket
- Anything Else you see necessary that I may have forgotten
- Helmet and Knee Pads (because they were in such popular demand)
