

Equipment Care and Use

-Tents

How many stakes? Minimum of 6

How Many Poles? 3

How Many Tarps? 2

Don't Leave tarps sticking out

Make all lines taught

No flames or gas in tents

No electronics – Period

No external framed backpacks

No food in tents

Stay Organized

How to Clean –

Sweep Tent Out

Spray Down and Hang Tarps

“ Fly

\Let all pieces dry thoroughly outside (not in drier) maybe on inside clothesline

Check for missing and/or damaged pieces

Properly re-roll tent

Gear Boxes –

How to use the troop wash station

- Wipe all solid food/sauce out of pot/pan

-1st bucket – soap and scrub

-2nd bucket – bleach

-3rd bucket – rinse

-Dry thoroughly

-Return to proper box

Make sure to clean the stove – Wipe it down

Return propane to propane yard

No metal spatulas in Teflon pans

At Home-

Re Wash all pots and pans – Preferably not in the dishwasher

Spray out Boxes

Let them dry outside

Scrub Table

Scrub Stove

Dispose of Left Over Food

-Rain Fly-

-Number of poles? 4 corner 2 main

-Number of stakes? 12

- Lay tarp & Rain fly out at home and sweep loose dirt off.
- If dry, wipe down with a clean damp cloth. Leave laying out to dry.
- If wet from rain, set tarp up with poles to dry.
- Be sure to stake down guy lines in-case of wind.
- Clean stakes go in pocket on side of pole bag.
- Once dry, roll up rain fly and place inside pole bag with poles.
- Place pole bag in carry bag.
- Roll rain fly and place inside carry bag with pole bag.
